#### **Ft. Myers**

The Alliance for the Arts, Fort Myers, announces the selection of environmental artist Michael Singer for a \$200,000 project for a portion of the campus grounds, a 2.2 acre site fronting McGregor Boulevard. Mr. Singer's integrative approach to the site will respond to area water quality issues and Southwest

Florida's history. Palm Beach-based Mr. Singer will work collaboratively with the project team which includes FAPAP emeritus board member and public art consultant Barbara Hill as well as a landscape architect and others to transform the Alliance grounds and retention pond, integrating public art and landscape with sidewalks, walkways, lighting, and signage.
