Benderson Development is requesting qualifications from artists and creative teams for a commissioned art opportunity for the primary roundabout leading into Nathan Benderson Park and University Town Center in Sarasota, FL. The Art Selection Committee would like to commission a 75-foot tall Signature Sculpture that is of the quality and stature that one would see at the Olympic games. The artwork should not depict any overt or obvious symbol of the Olympics but should - in a realistic, naturalistic or even abstract way - reflect, embody and convey movement and the power of enduring physical strength and health.
